### **SCBC REQUIREMENTS**

**Prior to working, successful candidates:**

- \* Must have or obtain a vulnerable Sector Check (VSC)
- \* Must hold an valid SCBC membership (Basic or higher) and sign an annual SCBC waiver

### **ROUTESETTER**

#### **Job description**

**Under the direction of the Head Routesetter, the Development Routesetter is responsible for:**

- Following the direction of the Head and Assistant Head Routesetters
- Set the problems or routes for the competition
- Forerun routes
- Listen and Learn
- Attend Competition Days for Personal Development.

**Successful candidates will have some/all of the following experience and skills:**

- Local/In House Competition Route Setting Experience
- Experience as a Competitor(Nationals or Higher)
- 3+ year commercial setting experience
- Ability to work well with others
- A good fore-running level for the role
- Knowledge of the current SCBC Rule amendments
- Knowledge SCBC policies related to competition
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**The selection committee for the Development Routesetting position will be as follows:**

- SCBC Route Setting Committee
- 1-2 Representative(s) from the SCBC Board
- 1 Representative from host facility

**The selection committee will review all applications using the following criteria in order of importance:**

#### **First Priority Criteria**

- Potential for growth into the role of Provincial Route Setter in the near future
- Potential longevity in the field of routes setting in BC
- Setting experiences in the discipline being applied for
- Setting experiences at a Local competition or Higher.
- Experience as a competitor
- Knowledge of the Field
- Development of Female Route Setters

#### **Second Priority Criteria**

- Knowledge of the current IFSC rules and regulations
- Proximity to the event host facility
- In House Setting Experience
